

# Middle School Community Service Project

As a component of Religion class, middle school students will do community service. This service will count towards to “project” section of the Religion grade for each trimester. The middle school community service project is organized as an overarching theme for each trimester. Throughout each trimester, middle school classes will work together to participate in community service projects related to the given theme.

Students are also required to complete a minimum of ten (10) hours of community service per trimester outside of class time related to the trimester’s theme. At the end of each trimester, students will create a reflective project in class to demonstrate the impact of both their whole-class and individual community service. Below are this year’s trimester themes.

- Trimester 1: Dignity of Humans
- Trimester 2: Dignity of Animals and the Environment
- Trimester 3: God’s Mercy

Community Service forms will be checked once at the midpoint of each trimester and will be due shortly before the end of the trimester. Below is a list of dates students should plan on having their community service logs prepared for their religion teacher.
